

# Manitoba's Strongest Golf Tournament - Tournament Rules

## Team Scramble - Breakdown

### Best Ball Scramble

Shotgun start will occur at 11:00am. All teams will gather at the start and will be carted out to their designated starting hole by a course marshall. Teams will rotate through the course until they complete all 18 holes. Please show up to the venue prior to 10:30am to ensure adequate time is given for your team to assemble and situate yourself with the cart selection and starting point. There will be an announcement at 10:50am prior to tee off going over tournament rules/scoring and events. The course will be open prior to 10:30am if you would like to take advantage of their driving range and putting green prior to the tournament. Costs for the driving range are not covered in the event registration.

All teams will keep track of score using **one** scorecard. Men will tee-off from the white tees and women from the red tees. You will progress through the hole by choosing the best ball either by the longest drive or best position. The other 3 of the players will pick up their shots and shoot their next shot from the shot the team deems best. To complete the hole the ball must go into the hole and there are no gimmies. You will write down your team's stroke score to complete the hole, not individual scores. Rules below:

- All team members Tee off at the start
- The team picks the best ball and plays all of their shots from that spot, repeated until the hole is completed.
- For shots off the fairway and rough, you will drop within one club-length from the chosen shot.
- For shots off the green, you will drop approximately one scorecard length from the chosen shot. Teams usually leave a mark close to where the ball stopped to assist with spotting the ball.
- In the event that a shot goes out-of-bounds there will be no re-tee's or mulligans to allow the flow of play to continue and the player will drop their next shot at the shot their team chooses.
- Points. 1-Point for PAR, 2-Points for Birdie, and 3-points for Eagle.

## **Speciality Holes / Games / Awards**

### **Worst Ball Scramble - Hole #5**

Hole #5 is a 136-yard / 107-yard Par 3. For this hole Team members will need to choose the worst of their teammates shots to complete the hole.

### **MPA Ball**

All teams are given 1 MPA Ball to which one member will play it for every shot on the hole that they have it. This ball will be rotated to each team member alternating turns every hole. If the team member sinks the ball into the hole to complete the hole your team gets to subtract one stroke from their final score for the hole. Your team will need to verify that they have the MPA ball at the end of the tournament. If your team loses the one MPA ball throughout the tournament your team will receive a 5-stroke penalty.

### **Longest Drive / Closest to the Pin / Putting Challenges**

Kingswood Golf Club will be setting up the Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin, and Putting Challenges on October 11th. More Information will be announced on October 11th at 10:50am prior to Shotgun start.

### **Sponsorship Holes**

More information will be given once confirmed. All specialty items and information will be announced at 10:50am prior to Shotgun at 11:00am.

### **Awards**

Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams, longest drive, closest to the pin, and putting challenges will be announced once the event is concluded. Each team will submit one scorecard to the event staff for scores to be tallied. Team winners will be determined by the lowest score. Tie Breaks will come down to team points. In the event there is a tie there will be a 1-hole playoff, in which each team selects two players to alternate shots, and the lowest score wins. If in this playoff hole both teams achieve the same score, the team that had the furthest putt to complete the hole will win. Awards will be announced in the Club house between 4-5pm once all scores are received. In order to accept awards you will need to be present.
